Since then, it has become a favorite way to gather Classical and Romantic music fans for a relaxed afternoon or evening of chamber music and refreshments. Detels has organized many such events during her teaching career at the University of Arkansas Dept. of Music (1982-2008), and this is the 5th annual Schubertiade she has organized and hosted since moving to Taos in 2014.
